CARRY WATER: No water is available at the trailhead or on the route

RECOMMEND: Dress in layers, use sunscreen, carry snacks. You may want to take a camera. This is a beautiful route along the creek and through the woods. At the turnaround there is a nice flat spot to picnic in the snow if it's a nice sunny day.
