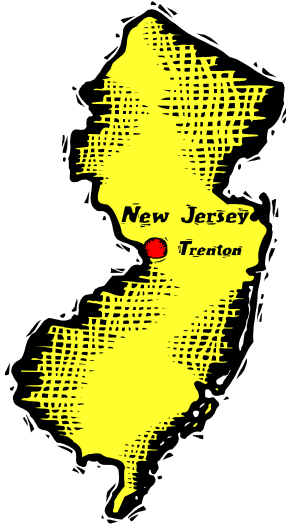

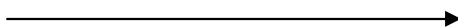

## VCWP MAY 2011 MEETING MINUTES

22 May 2011 -

### Treasurer's Report

\$1363.86 balance at end of April 2011. (Our best quarterly ending balance since 2007.) Rolling revenue over expenses \$511.70. This does not include the Tater Tours walkers in May.

\$250 in dues received thus far for 2011.

The stamp for the Fort Montgomery walk box was missing. Replacement cost was \$25 plus \$18 overnight delivery fee.

### Old Business

Nancy Patrick brought up that a few months ago there was discussion regarding paying for the Convention walks for the delegate for the convention. There has been past precedent for this since Steve Lowe was delegate many years ago. Vote of members present: 6 for, 2 against, 1 abstain.

VCWP May 14 West Point Walk Event and May 15 Beacon Walk Event - weather prediction for both days was poor. Attendance was fairly low, but the weather did hold off during the walks. Betty shared that a nice thank you was received from Valerie regarding these walks. (Betty also sent a thank you to Valerie for the delicious cookies.)

Joan Vorbach, Brenda Presnal and Joan Kimmel were instrumental in meeting the Tater Tours walkers for their walks of our West Point, Hyde Park and Rhinebeck YREs.

Andrew said he was in contact with Peggy Goetz regarding the start point for the Nyack Event in September.

Reminder that we used to set out a donation jar for events. The donation jar income supports our donations to the organizations of the sites for some of our walks (such as Scenic Hudson, Walkway over the Hudson).

### New Business

A thank you letter was received with suggestions for changes in walk instructions for the West Point 7K and Highland Falls 10K YREs. Mike Green will take the comments into consideration in adjusting the walk instructions for these walks.

Add emergency VCWP contact phone numbers on walk in-

structions.

Walking Adventures International (WAI) is bringing two different bus tours to West Point (Mon, Oct 12 and Wed, Oct 14). The Patricks will meet the bus tours and be in charge if any "social events" will be scheduled for the tours and VCWP.

Farrell suggested we allow up to \$5 for carrots for the Army Mules for tour groups coming to West Point. Joan & Brenda bought carrots for the Tater Tours walk of West Point this past week and should be reimbursed.

There was some discussion of whether VCWP meetings should be scheduled separate from the pre group walk breakfasts, as time seems rushed. Because of time constraint this discussion was not brought to conclusion.
