



Over 267 years ago in December of 1742, Count Nicholas Ludwig von Zinzendorf of Saxony, the leader and organizer of the modern day Moravian Church, stopped and preached at the tavern of Jacob Huber, located north of Lititz along the Newport Road. Count Zinzendorf was searching for a tract of land for the establishment of a religious community similar to those in Bethlehem and Nazareth, Pennsylvania. John George Klein, who was not in attendance at the tavern, followed Count Zinzendorf to Lancaster where he preached the next day. At Lancaster, Klein was won over by the Count's cause and was inspired to turn over his tract of land. The tract consisted of 491 acres that meandered along Carter's Run (today known as the Lititz Run), which became the new settlement. On June 12, 1756, a letter from Europe addressed to the Moravian Brethren, was received from Count Zinzendorf, in which he named the new settlement Lititz. This year's walk in Lititz by the Penn Dutch Pacers is monumental on a number of fronts. First and foremost we are offering this walk, again this year, as the second leg of a GREAT Central Pennsylvania Walking Weekend. We encourage you to walk the Susquehanna Rover's walks in Hershey either on Friday and Saturday and then come join us in Lititz on Sunday, hopefully with much better weather than last year.

We are excited to offer a brand new startpoint at the Freeze & Frizz which is located directly across from Wilbur Chocolate right on Broad St (Route 501) which runs north and south through the center of Lititz. This new startpoint will allow us to offer a brand new trail with exciting new Lititz vistas along with the Lititz favorites. And of course for those of you who have been collecting them over the past eleven years, the patch for this year's Lititz walk marks the last of the Penn Dutch Pacers series of 12 patches based on the classic 12 Days of Christmas song lyrics. If you have been a collector or you just want to be sure to get a patch this year we would suggest pre-registering for this event. See you in Lititz!!

Directions to Lititz Startpoint

Points East - New Jersey, New York, and Philadelphia using the PA Turnpike: Exit PA Turnpike at the Reading / Lancaster interchange and proceed SOUTH on Rt. 222. Exit Rt. 222 at Rt. 772 (Brownstown Exit) and proceed WEST to Lititz. Turn Right go two blocks Freeze & Frizz is on the right immediately after crossing the railroad tracks (directly across the street from Wilbur Chocolate).

Central PA - York, Hanover, Harrisburg, Gettysburg, etc: Rt. 30 EAST to Rt. 501 North Exit Rt. 501 NORTH to Lititz (approximately 6.5 miles). Freeze & Frizz is on the right immediately after crossing the railroad tracks (directly across the street from Wilbur Chocolate).

Central PA - via PA Turnpike: PA Turnpike to Lancaster / Lebanon Interchange (Exit 20) Go SOUTH on Rt. 72 to Manheim Turn LEFT on Fruitville Pk/Rt 772 east and proceed to Lititz where it becomes W Orange St. Turn left (north) on Broad Street (501). Freeze & Frizz is on the right immediately across the street from Wilbur Chocolate.

Points South - Baltimore, Washington D.C., etc: Interstate I-83 (in Baltimore I-295) NORTH to US Route 30 East. Route 30 EAST to Rt. 501 North. Exit NORTH on 501 to Lititz (approximately 6.5 miles) Freeze & Frizz is on the right immediately after crossing the railroad tracks (directly across the street from Wilbur Chocolate).

PLEASE NOTE: We endeavor to provide the most accurate directions possible, but they are intended to be used with a map of the area or driving directions from sources such as MapQuest or Mapblast. Distances given are close approximations and may vary slightly from the actual driving distances. Please use them only as a guide for getting to the start point.

STARTING TIMES AND DATE: Sunday ONLY, November 29 • Start anytime between 8:00 AM and 1:00 PM, finish by 4:00 PM.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The 10K trail is entirely within the boundaries of Lititz Borough and Warwick Township and is rated 2. Sidewalks, paved trails, and a section of narrow roadway would be useable by wheelchairs but not recommended especially during inclement weather.

DISCLAIMER: The Penn Dutch Pacers cannot be held responsible for any lost or stolen items, damage, accidents or injuries of any kind at any time. Every reasonable effort will be made by the sponsors to make the event safe, enjoyable and memorable for everyone.

CONDITIONS: Littering is forbidden along the trail. Pets are welcome and must be leashed at all times. Also all local ordinances requiring cleaning up after your pets must be followed. All participants must carry a validated Start Card. Events will be held regardless of weather conditions.

ELIGIBILITY: All are welcome to participate but must register at the start. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian unless participating with an organized and supervised youth group.

AWARD: The award, a full color embroidered patch as pictured on the front of this brochure, is the last of the Penn Dutch Pacer series of 12 patches, each depicting the 12 days of Christmas.

REGISTRATION: Every participant must register and carry a Start Card.

- Participation only, without IVV Credit, is \$2.00, children 12 and under may participate for free.

- The fee for IVV credit is \$3.00

- Credit & award \$7.00 pre-registered and \$8.00 day of event.
