

**Directions to Rocky Ridge County Park:** 3699 Deininger Road, York, PA 17406

**From Gettysburg or Lancaster:** From US-30 E or W, take Mt Zion Road (Rt 24) north for one mile. Turn right onto Deininger Road. Follow one mile to the park. Park in lower lot and follow signs to start point.

**From Harrisburg:** I-83 S to US-30 E. Follow above directions.

**From Baltimore:** I-83 N to US-30 E. Follow above directions.

**DATE:** Saturday, April 28– Sunday, April 29, 2012

**SPONSOR:** York White Rose Wanderers, AVA-236

**SANCTIONED BY:** This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports. This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement awards.

**PROCEDURE:** AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is stamped at control points along the course. At the Finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Walk at your own pace. Runners are welcome!

**REGISTRATION and FEES:** This event is free to those who wish to participate without IVV credit. IVV credit is \$3.00. There is no pre-registration.

**CONDITIONS:** The event will be held regardless of the weather. There will be no littering. Wildlife and plant life are not to be disturbed. No refunds. Pets must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in any buildings. Please clean up after your pet.

**PARKING:** Park in the lower lot and follow signs to the start point

**AWARD:** None.

Start Location: Rocky Ridge County Park, 3699 Deininger Road, York, PA 17406

Rocky Ridge Park was the first York county park. It is a 750 acre park with a mature mixed oak forest. Prime attractions are the multi-use trails, the picnic pavilions, and the scenic views of the Susquehanna Valley from the observation decks located in the park. The decks are an excellent place to view migratory birds, like hawks, eagles, and falcons heading north in the Spring.

**TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS:** The walk is mostly on natural woodland trails with a few inclines. It will not be suitable for strollers or wheelchairs.

Special Programs: Strolling Somewhere Over the Rainbow (York is known as the White Rose City).

**YORK WHITE ROSE WANDERER WALKS:** Don't forget to take in one of our Year Round Events while in this area. The York-Lincoln Highway Walk starts at the Hampton Inn at 1550 Mount Zion Rd, York, PA 17402. The Hampton Inn is on the left between US-30 and Deininger Road. There are six walks and two bikes along the York Heritage Rail Trail south of York. There are also three walks and a bike in Gettysburg, one in Hanover, and one in Littlestown.
